- College preparation (e.g., ACT or SAT preparation, exploration, advanced placement classes or testing)
- Career preparation (e.g., technology skills, internships)
- Gifted and talented program
- Student advocacy and leadership
- Culturally responsive mentoring
- Substance abuse prevention
- Culturally responsive counseling
- Family literacy with culturally based materials
- Parent Involvement
- Culturally responsive professional development (required)
