 - d. Support the LEA in its effort to identify and certify all eligible Native American students as required by Section 251.50 of the Code of Federal Regulations (CFR 34).
 - e. Act as a review body for all individual or group who may wish to propose changes, additions, or to express relevant concerns regarding the Native American Program.
 - f. Attend regularly scheduled and special meetings.
 - g. Become familiar with the rules and regulations of the Indian Education Act.
 - h. Perform other duties as assigned to the group or individual members.
